The Manager, Catch Certification Unit reports to the Executive Manager Audit, Certification and Trade (AC&T).

Key Responsibilities:

- Effective management of NFA's Catch Documentation and Certification System to ensure traceability at all levels of fishing operations for export
- Support efforts to combat IUU in all forms through monitoring, data collection and catch certification
- Develop programs that enable the traceability and data collection of fishery products to certify the legality and eligibility of fisheries product
- Contribute to policy development initiatives and be familiar with domestic and regional issues affecting the fishery in the area of conservation management measures, a broad range of market requirements and IUU requirements

Expected Competencies:

- Degree in Fisheries Science, Economics and Business. Post graduate qualifications would be well regarded
- Minimum of 10 years' experience in operational fisheries management with at least 5 years' in a managerial position
